

## **2016 Dwyer Williams Potter Attorneys, LLP Law School Scholarship**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Recipient is a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States
- Recipient is accepted, and will be attending, their first year of law school in the fall of 2016
- Academic achievement as reflected by an undergraduate cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA
- Recipient must have received a bachelor's degree from an undergraduate college in the United States

**REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must submit the following by July 1st, 2016:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form
- One to three (1-3) page typed essay
- An official and complete copy of undergraduate college transcripts
- An acceptance letter from an accredited law school within the United States
- Proof of legal residency in the U.S. (i.e., birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)

**AWARD:**

- DWP scholarship is to be used exclusively for law school tuition and related expenses.
- A check for \$1,000 will be made payable to the award recipient's law school to cover these expenses.
- Recipient is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.
- DWP Scholarship award recipient will be notified of the selection on or about August 1, 2016.
